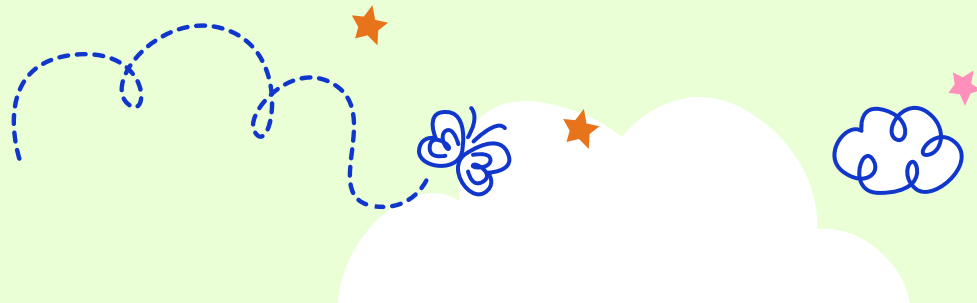



From supporting local charities to conserving the environment, volunteering offers opportunities for individuals to make meaningful contributions to their communities and causes they care about.

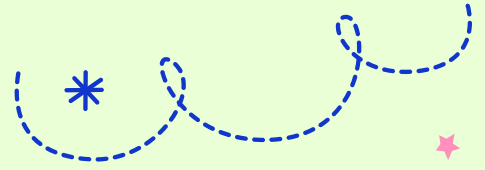


- cleaning up parks, beaches, or neighborhoods

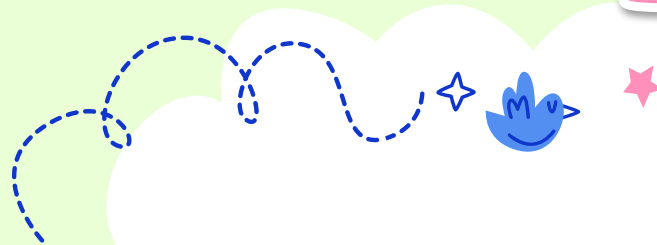
# Motivation and Retention

## Acknowledgement and Appreciation

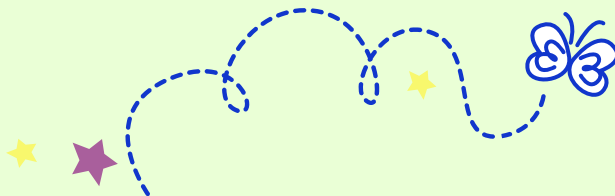
Regularly expressing gratitude to volunteers for their contributions fosters a culture of appreciation and encourages continued engagement.

Sharing volunteer stories and achievements through newsletters, social media, or organizational publications showcases their impact and inspires others to get involved.



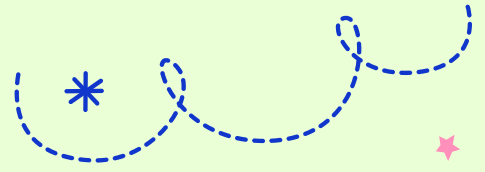
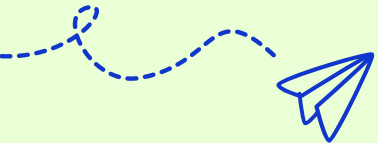
# Personalized Thank You Notes and Tokens of Appreciation

Sending personalized thank you notes or small tokens of appreciation demonstrates thoughtfulness and makes volunteers feel valued and recognized for their unique contributions.

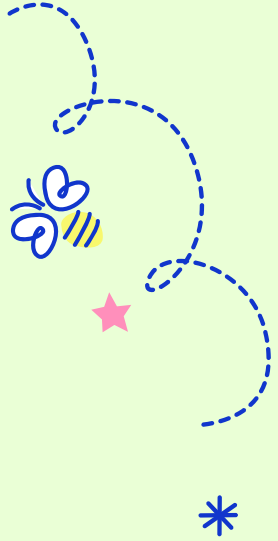

★ Engaging volunteers in planning and executing appreciation events allows them to feel valued and connected to the organization, fostering a sense of ownership and community.

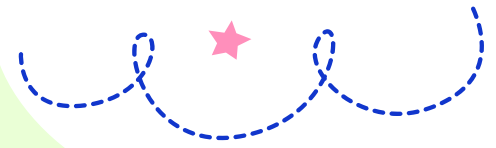
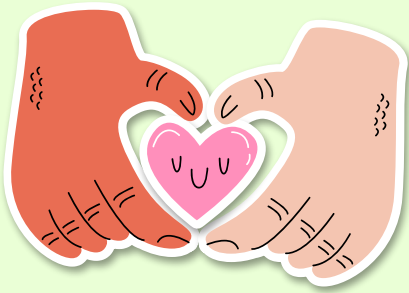


# Create Memorable Experiences

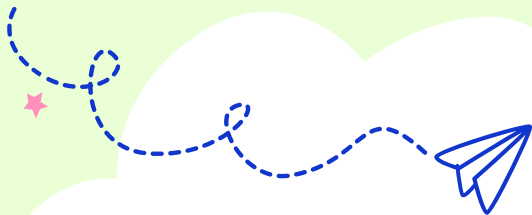
Incorporating meaningful activities, personalized touches, and opportunities for volunteers to connect with each other and the mission enhances their experience and encourages continued involvement.

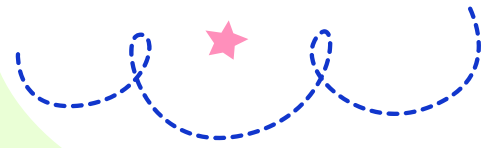
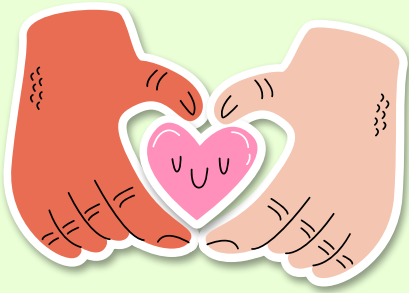

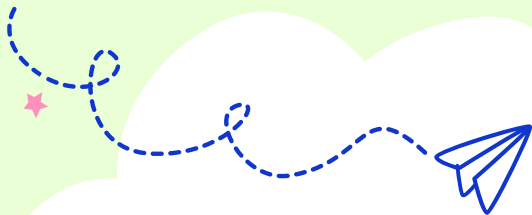
